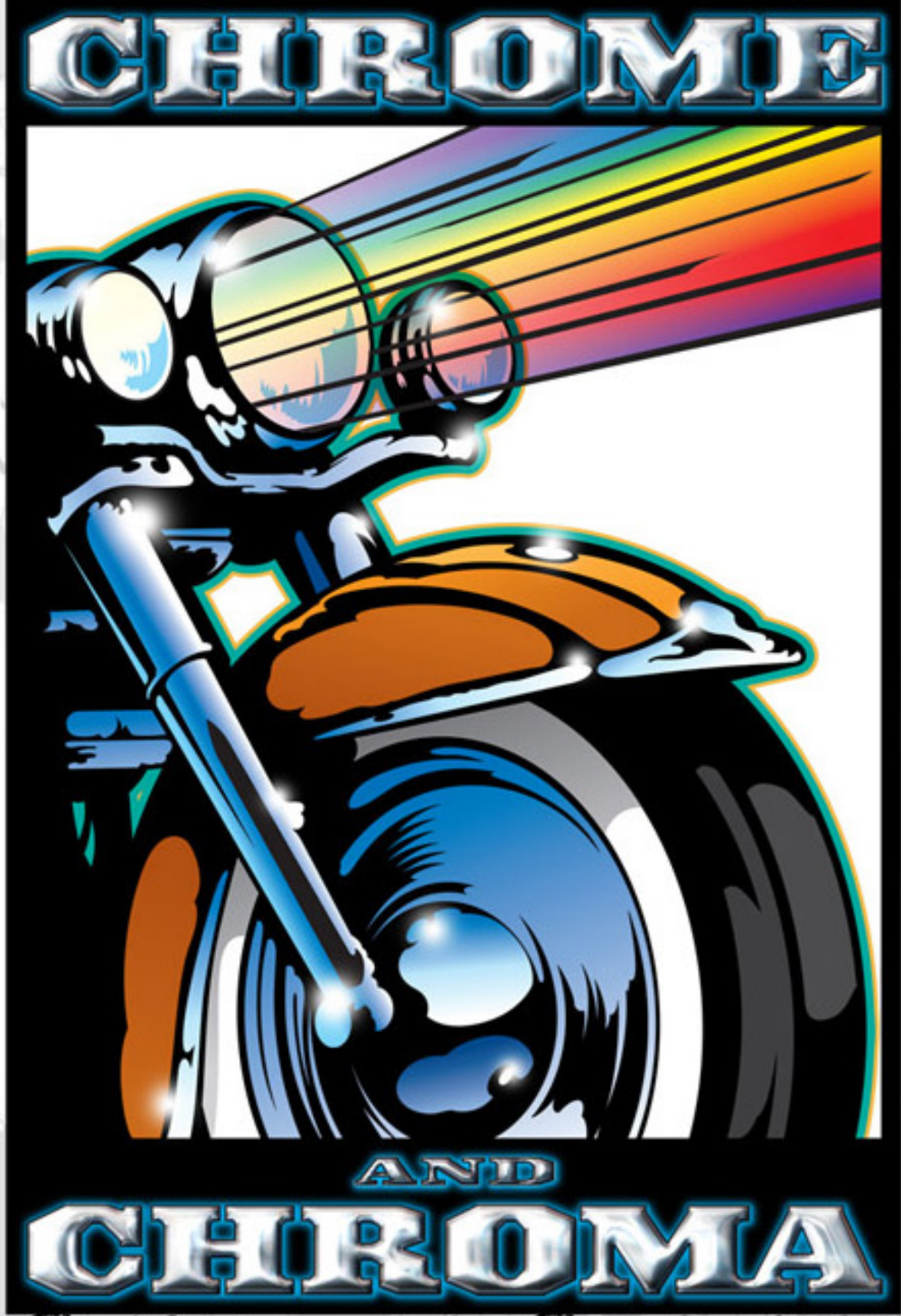
Opening Exhibit Date: Friday, August 1st, 2008, Starting at 6 pm.

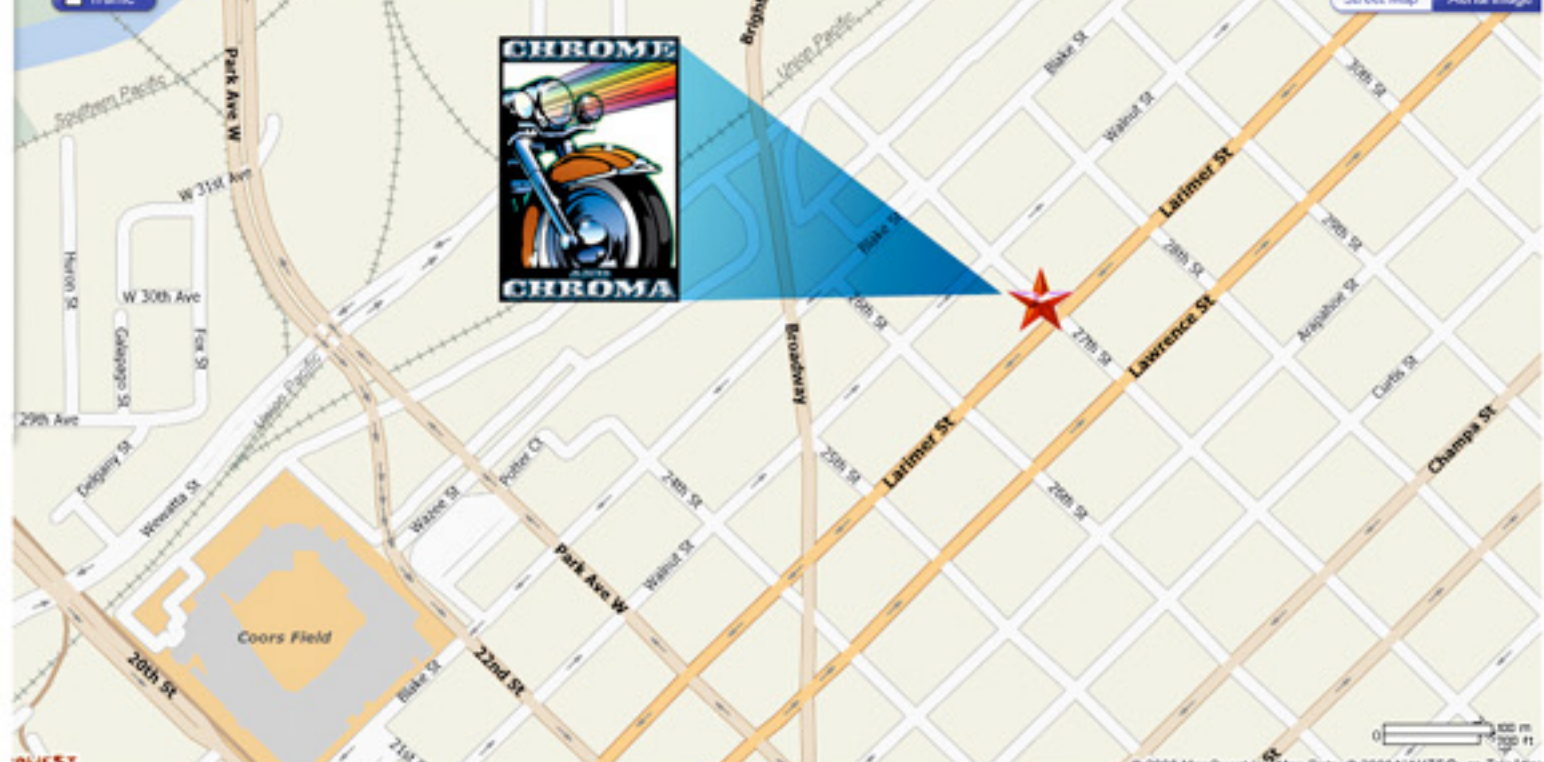
